Aimed at gathering substantial data on the ways global higher education systems are affected by the pandemic from an institutional standpoint, the Survey includes questions about the challenges encountered in four different areas: **Governance and financing, teaching and learning, research, and societal/community engagement.**

Finally, the survey report will feed into the *UNESCO World Higher Education Conference 2021* – a multi-stakeholder intergovernmental event aimed at defining the future of higher education.
